1. Brief about PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana

PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana is launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 13.02.2024. This scheme aims to install solar rooftops on **1 crore households** across the country.

The State Government of Uttar Pradesh has set a target to install solar rooftop plants on **25 Lakh households**. Detailed DISCOM-wise and District-wise targets are provided in this document.

Salient Features of the scheme are as follows:

- Electricity from solar rooftops is provided free to consumers; surplus electricity goes back to the grid and is adjusted in their electricity bills via net metering by DISCOM.
- Approx. **10 sq. m. of shade-free roof space** is needed for installing a 1 kW solar plant.
- **1 kW** rooftop plant typically generates **4 to 5 units of electricity daily**.
- Installation costs range from Rs 60,000 to Rs 65,000 per kilowatt, with a 25-year lifespan ensuring free electricity thereafter.
- Consumers recover their initial investment in **3-4 years** through savings.

The scheme encourages more private consumers to participate by offering grants from both the Central and State Governments, details of which are provided in this document. Currently, there are approximately 1000 registered vendors authorized by MNRE, Government of India, to install these rooftop plants.

Scheme Eligibility

- All Residential households/ RWA under LMV-1 with a metered connection are eligible.
- Subsidy is applicable only for the usage of Domestically Manufactured Solar Modules as per ALMM list released by MNRE.

Bank Loan

Solar rooftop systems can be financed through bank loans with affordable EMI at interest rates as low as 7% (through PM Jan-Samarth Portal or offline mode at Banks)

महोदय,

अवगत करण है कि मा0 प्रशासकीय जी द्वारा दिनांक 13.02.2024 को पी0एम0 पूर्व वर: कुल किराणी सेवाएं का सुधारण किया गया है। इसके अंतर्गत देह के 01 करोड़ वरों को अर्थात्तित विदे करने का लक्ष्य निर्धारित किया गया है। सोलर कपटॉप में उत्पन्नित किराणी मुक्त क्षेत्रों, निम्न उपरोध उपभोक्ता अपनी विद्युत आवश्यकता की पूर्ति हेतु कर सकेंगा। केन्द्र सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित लक्ष्य के सापेक्ष प्रदेश में 25 लाख वरों पर सोलर कपटॉप संघों की स्थापित किया जाना लक्षित है।

सोलर कपटॉप संघों की स्थापना हेतु प्रति किलोवाट 10 वर्गमीटर छाया परीत छत की आवश्यकता होती है। 01 किलोवाट के कपटॉप संघ के औसतत प्रतिदिन 4-5 मुफ्त किराणी का उत्पादन होता है। संघों के उत्पन्नित विद्युत का उपयोग वन स्वामी द्वारा करने के उपरान्त अल्पेय विद्युत फिट में जारी जारी है जिसका टेन्टीरिग के माध्यम में विद्युत बिज में समावेशन संबंधित विच्छेद-द्वारा किया जाता है। उपभोक्ता द्वारा सोलर संघों की स्थापना में अथ की गयी अर्पणति की प्रतिपूर्ति विद्युत बिज के अन्त के रूप में 3 से 4 वर्षों में हो जाती है। संघों का सीधेपदात लक्षण 25 वर्ष का होता है। अतः शेष 21 वर्षों तक संघों के उत्पन्नित विद्युत उपभोक्ता को मुक्त प्राप्त होती रहेगी। उक्त योजना का लाभ अधिकारिक निजी उपभोक्ताओं को प्राप्त हो सके तथा वे प्रीत हो कर अन्त स्वयं का "डीग पावर हब" स्थापित कर सकें, दस हेतु केन्द्र सरकार के अनुदान के अतिरिक्त उत्तर

3. एक से दस किलोवाट अकार के संघ का अनुमानित मूल्य प्रति किलोवाट लक्षण वर0 60 से 65 हजार प्रति किलोवाट के मध्य आता है। संघों की स्थापना के उपरान्त केन्द्र एवं राज्य सरकार से प्राप्त अनुदान उपभोक्ता के अकाउंट में प्राप्त होता है। योजना का लाभ प्राप्त करने हेतु केन्द्र सरकार <https://pmsuryaghar.gov.in/> पर अंतर्गत अनुदान अकाउंट करना होता है। प्रक्रिया को ताल बनाने के लिए भारत सरकार द्वारा अंतर्गत ऐप भी विकसित किया गया है, जिस पर अकाउंट किया जा सकता है। सोलर कपटॉप संघों की स्थापना बैंक में अथ बैंक अकाउंट बनाने हेतु भारत सरकार के पोर्टल पर विकसित बैंक को मुवीबद्ध किया गया है, जिसका लाभ उपभोक्ता द्वारा प्राप्त किया जा सकता है। सोलर कपटॉप संघों की स्थापना हेतु एच0एम0आर0ओ0, भारत सरकार के रिमा-निर्देशन में केन्द्र इम्पैलमेण्ट की कार्यवाही की जा रही है, जिसके अंतर्गत प्रदेश में 525 वेक्टर सर्वेक्षण में पंजीकृत हो चुके हैं। प्रदेश हेतु सोलर कपटॉप संघों की स्थापना के निर्धारित लक्ष्य 25 लाख के सापेक्ष डिजिटल/अनपेक्षित लक्ष्य निम्नवत् निर्धारित किया जाता है:



In reference to your letter No. 775/UPNED/PMSURYGHAR/2024-25 dated 17.05.2024 vide which it has been requested to issue necessary instructions to UPPCL regarding the changes in the requirement of Technical Feasibility Report (TFR) in line with the provisions contained in Electricity (Rights of Consumers) Amendment Rules, 2024 notified by the Ministry of Power, Govt. of India on 22.02.2024, the Commission approves the following amendments to the previously approved Procedure and Timeline vide letter No. UPERC/ Secy/(VCA)/2023-1769 dated 20.03.2023:	
<i>"i) For installation of roof top solar photo voltaic systems, the technical feasibility study shall be completed within a period of fifteen days and the outcome of the study shall be intimated to the applicant, failing which it shall be presumed that the proposal is technically feasible.</i>	
<i>ii) The applications for roof top solar photo voltaic systems upto 10 kW capacity, complete in all respects shall be deemed to have been accepted without requiring technical feasibility study and any commensurate enhancement of the sanctioned load of the consumer, as may be required, shall be carried out by the distribution licensee."</i>	
All other provisions of the previously approved Procedure and Timeline shall remain the same.



And whereas, the _____ (Name of the Licensee) agrees to provide grid connectivity to the eligible consumer for injection of the electricity generated from his RSPV plant of capacity _____ KWs into the power system of Licensee and as per conditions of this agreement and net metering regulations/orders issued by the Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission.

Both the parties hereby agree to as follows

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. Eligibility for net metering has been specified in the UPERC (Rooftop Solar PV Grid Interactive System Gross / Net Metering) Regulations, 2019 (hereinafter referred to as RSPV Regulations, 2019). Eligible consumer is required to be aware, in advance, of the standards and conditions his system has to meet for being integrated into grid/distribution system.

2. Technical and Interconnection Requirements

- 2.1. The eligible consumer agrees that his Rooftop Solar PV generation plant and net metering system will conform to the standards and requirements specified in these regulations and in the following Regulations and codes as amended from time to time.
 - i. Central Electricity Authority (Technical Standards for connectivity of the Distributed Generating Resources) Regulations, 2013 and subsequent amendments thereof,
 - ii. Central Electricity Authority (Installation and Operation of Meters) Regulation 2006 and subsequent amendments thereof,
 - iii. Central Electricity Authority (Measures of Safety and Electricity Supply) Regulations, 2010 and subsequent amendments thereof,
 - iv. UPERC Electricity Grid Code, 2007 and subsequent amendments thereof,
 - v. UPERC (Grant of Connectivity to Intra-State Transmission System) Regulations, 2010 and subsequent amendments thereof to the extent specified in the UPERC RSPV Regulations, 2019,
 - vi. UPERC Supply Code Regulations 2005 and subsequent amendments thereof,
 - vii. Any other provisions applicable to the electricity consumer of the Distribution Licensee.
- 2.2. Eligible consumer agrees that he has installed or will install, prior to connection of Photovoltaic system to Licensee's distribution system, an isolation device (both automatic and inbuilt within inverter and external manual relays) and agrees for the Licensee to have access to and operation of this, if required and for repair & maintenance of the distribution system.
- 2.3. Eligible consumer agrees that in case of a power outage on Licensee's system, photovoltaic system will disconnect/isolate automatically and his plant will not inject power into Licensee's distribution system.

- 2.4. All the equipment connected to distribution system shall be compliant with relevant International (IEEE/IEC) or Indian standards (BIS) and installations of electrical equipment must comply with Central Electricity Authority (Measures of Safety and Electricity Supply) Regulations, 2010.

- 2.5. Eligible consumer agrees that Licensee will specify the interface/interconnection point and metering point.

- 2.6. Eligible consumer and Licensee agree to comply with the relevant CEA and UPERC Regulations in respect of operation and maintenance of the plant, drawing and diagrams, site responsibility schedule, harmonics, synchronization, voltage, frequency, flicker etc.

- 2.7. Due to Licensee's obligation to maintain a safe and reliable distribution system, eligible consumer agrees that if it is determined by the Licensee that eligible consumer's photovoltaic system either causes damage to and/or produces adverse effects affecting other consumers or Licensee's assets, eligible consumer will have to disconnect photovoltaic system immediately from the distribution system upon direction from the Licensee and correct the problem at his own expense prior to a reconnection.

3. Clearances and Approvals

Annexure 1: UPERC RSPV Regulations, 2019 and its amendments

- The eligible consumers of Distribution Licensee shall be entitled to install Solar Rooftop system under net-metering arrangement
- If the eligible consumer installs solar rooftop under net metering scheme, such eligible consumer shall be entitled to use the power generated from the solar rooftop at his premises, and the surplus power can be injected to the distribution system of the Licensee at the interconnection point
- The maximum peak capacity of the solar rooftop system shall not exceed 100% of the connected/contracted demand of the consumer.
- The capacity of the solar rooftop system to be installed by any eligible consumer shall not be less than 1 kWp and shall not exceed 2 MWp

Annexure 2: MNRE Guidelines – Incentive to Urban Local Bodies

Salient features

- The document is an Operational Guideline for Implementation of Component "Incentives to Local Bodies" under PM-Suryaghar: Muft Bijli Yojana.
- This component aims to incentivize Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) & Panchayat Raj Institutions (PRIs) at the Gram Panchayat level to promote the deployment of residential rooftop solar within their respective jurisdictions.
- Every installation in the residential segment under PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana in the jurisdiction of the ULB or PRI, for which the Central Financial Assistance has been transferred to the concerned consumer through the National Portal under the scheme guidelines shall be considered for calculating the incentive made out to the concerned ULB/PRI.
- The National Programme Implementation Agency shall be responsible for the implementation of this scheme component and shall exercise due care to ensure that the incentive against an installation under the scheme is given to the concerned ULB/PRI only once.
- ULBs and PRIs are expected to promote the scheme through door-to-door mobilization, awareness campaigns, and local events, while actively engaging with stakeholders like vendors, banks, and DISCOMs to facilitate demand generation and application processing.
- Gram Panchayats or Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in their respective areas shall be provided financial assistance in the form of direct financial support with an incentive of ₹ 1,000 per installation in their respective jurisdiction.
- The District Level Committee constituted under the scheme chaired by the District Magistrate will monitor the work undertaken by their respective ULBs & PRIs for the promotion of the scheme.

Annexure 3: MNRE Guidelines – Incentive to DISCOM

- The document is an operational guideline for the implementation of the component "Incentives to Discoms" under PM-Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana, a scheme aimed at installing rooftop solar plants in one crore households.
- The scheme has a provision to incentivize DISCOMs to enable them to undertake tasks more effectively and to create a greater motivation within DISCOMs as SIAs for the scheme.
- The incentives to DISCOMs will be based on achievement in installation of additional grid-connected rooftop solar capacity in all sectors over and above the base level.
- The DISCOMs shall create dedicated RTS teams at Discom HQ, Circle, till division level, by provisioning for hiring of contractual manpower within the scheme.
- Incentives to DISCOMs will be based on the incremental rooftop solar (RTS) capacity installed by DISCOMs in their distribution areas
- The incentives will be assessed against a base level defined by data from the Grid Connected Rooftop Solar Phase II scheme.
- Incentives are limited to the first additional 18,000 MW of rooftop solar capacity installed since the start of the Phase II program.
- For capacity achieved above 10% and less than 15% of the installed base capacity, 5% incentive will be provided
- For capacity achieved beyond 15% of the installed base capacity, 10% incentive will be provided
- The calculation will consider the installed base capacity at the end of the previous financial year.
- The incentives will be assessed on a financial year basis, covering the period from 01.04.2024 to 31.03.2025, and continuing through the program's duration.
- The DISCOMs shall allocate 10% of the incentives received (up to Rs. 1 crore) for rewards system for DISCOM officials and functionaries.
- The DISCOMs shall allocate at least 50 % of the incentives (up to Rs 1 crore of allocation per division) for dedicated utilization at the division and subdivisional level.

- The component aims to create more than 3 lakh skilled manpower, through fresh skilling, and up-skilling, under scheme component of capacity building, out of which at least 1,00,000 will be Solar PV Technicians.
- The scheme also aims to undertake capacity building of DISCOMs, REDAs, Financial Institutions as well as officials, field units and stakeholders of other Ministries/Departments at the Centre and State levels, through constructive convergence of efforts.
- The National Programme Implementing Agency (NPIA) for the scheme shall be responsible for implementation and monitoring of the Skilling and Capacity Building at the National Level. The State Implementation Agencies (SIAs) shall be responsible for implementation and monitoring of the Skilling and Capacity Building at the State/UT Level.
- The NPIA shall undertake an independent third-party evaluation of the skilling and capacity building programme at the time of mid-term review of the scheme.
- The PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana will be promoted through collaboration with various central and state ministries, including capacity-building activities for Self Help Groups and cooperatives.

Annexure 5: MNRE Guidelines – Awareness and Outreach

- The document is an operational guideline for the implementation of the component "Capacity Building" under PM-Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana, a scheme aimed at installing rooftop solar plants in one crore households
- The component aims to create awareness and disseminate information regarding the benefits available under PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana. Various channels for promotion will be utilized, including public campaigns, social media, print media, television, Radio jingles, nukkad and door-to-door campaigns.
- The National Programme Implementing Agency (NPIA) shall be responsible for implementation and monitoring of the Awareness and Outreach scheme component for the scheme at the National Level. The State Implementation Agencies (SIAs) shall be responsible for implementation and monitoring of the Awareness and Outreach scheme component at the State Level.
- The NPIA shall formulate the National Awareness and Outreach Plan for PM Surya Ghar (NAOP-PMSG), with the approval of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy. The SIA shall formulate the State Awareness and Outreach Plan (SAOP), with the approval of MNRE through NPIA.
- The NPIA shall monitor the implementation of the Awareness and outreach Plans in coordination with other Departments of Central Government and their Nodal Implementation agencies and SIAs.
